



# Refill Instructions - Canon BCI-15

Canon : i70, i80, i90

## Colour Refilling Instructions.

1. Peel back label on top of colour cartridge. This will expose the 3 filling holes.
2. Enlarge filling holes with screw piece supplied in the kit.
3. Assemble the syringe and steel filling tube and fill with the appropriate colour ink.
4. Push steel filling tube into the correct filling hole as shown in diagram.

**IMPORTANT:** The cartridge contains a sponge and slight resistance may be felt.

5. SLOWLY inject ink into the cartridge. When ink overflows from filling hole cartridge is full. Stop injecting ink immediately. Unused ink may be returned to bottle.

**IMPORTANT:** Clean syringe with water and dry for future use or use with a different colour ink.

6. Leave cartridge to stand on a protective, non-absorbent surface overnight to ensure no leakage and to give the ink time to saturate the sponge.

7. Install the cartridge and run a cleaning cycle as per printer instructions.

## Black Refilling Instructions.

1. Peel back label on top of black cartridge. This will expose the filling hole.
2. Enlarge filling hole with silver screw piece supplied in the kit.
3. Assemble the syringe and steel filling tube and fill with the appropriate black ink.
4. Push steel filling tube into the correct filling hole as shown in diagram.

**IMPORTANT:** The cartridge contains a sponge and slight resistance may be felt.

5. SLOWLY inject ink into the cartridge. When ink overflows from filling hole cartridge is full. Stop injecting ink immediately. Unused ink may be returned to bottle.

**IMPORTANT:** Clean syringe with water and dry for future use.

6. Leave cartridge to stand on a protective, non-absorbent surface overnight to ensure no leakage and to give the ink time to saturate the sponge.

7. Install the cartridge and run a cleaning cycle as per printer instructions.

**IMPORTANT:** For best results, refill whilst ink still remains in cartridge. Empty cartridges should be refilled immediately.
